

## ATR on Feedback (2021- 2022)

### 1. Areas of Concern Identified in

#### a. Students' General Feedback

Students were asked to provide response to 21 parameters of general feedback of college. Parameters for which students provided response percentage, 5% or more in Poor category were analysed and following actions were taken:

- i. Drinking Water Facility: Water samples from purifiers installed at various locations in college were tested for TDS. Time to time service and change of filters is assessed by college building in-charge and desired action is taken.
- ii. Sports Facility: HOD of Department of Physical Education was informed to take necessary action.
- iii. Eatables in Canteen: The college canteen contract was renewed and a teacher in-charge has been appointed to supervise the food quality, prices and servicing regularly.

#### b. Teachers' Feedback by Students

Students were asked to provide response to 14 parameters of teacher's evaluation survey. There was not even a single parameter for which students provided response percentage, 5% or more in Poor category.

#### c. Teacher's Feedback

Teachers were asked to provide response to 8 parameters about curriculum, college infrastructure, resources and administrative support. There was not even a single parameter for which teachers provided response percentage, 5% or more in Poor category. The response to adequacy of syllabus for expectations of industry and employers (S. No. 2) was 11.1%. The administration has decided to run value added courses from next academic session (2022-23) to meet the gap of academia and industry.


#### d. Alumni Feedback

Alumni were asked to provide response to 18 parameters. Parameters for which they provided response percentage, 5% or more in Poor category were analysed and following actions were taken:

- i. Institute-Parents Relationship: To improve the response percentage (9.4%, S.No. 5), college administration organized Youth Parliament (May 14, 2022) and parents were invited to attend the event. Feedback from parents was received telephonically

by respective class in-charges. The queries related to curriculum, class tests performance or any other grievance were addressed by faculty members.

- ii. Laboratory Facilities: Laboratories of all departments have been upgraded with modern equipment under various schemes of by Govt. of India (DBT, DST-FIST, CPE).
- iii. Furniture in Classrooms: DAV College is more than 100 years old institute. The furniture in classrooms is repaired and replaced time to time as requested by students or faculty members of the college. Furniture in Platinum Jubilee Block was renovated in June 2022
- iv. Co-operation by Non-teaching Staff: Lab staff are encouraged to attend workshops to improve their command on the practical handling of various subjects. Administrator takes necessary action to make the practical learning experience comfortable and productive for our students.
- v. Parking Facility: Students and faculty members of college have been provided with parking facility inside and at the backside of campus. Students are charged a nominal fee for availing parking facility and it is free of cost for faculty members.
