A Research and Development Cell has been restructured at DAV College, Jalandhar as per new guidelines of UGC-2022. The cell is established with a vision to put in place robust mechanism for developing and strengthening the research ecosystem within the college, aligned with the provisions of NEP 2020.

Mission

The establishment of RDC will help in creating new knowledge, creating a research ecosystem for reliable, impactful and sustained research output and facilitating intellectual growth that would promote quality research & contribute meaningfully towards the goal of a self-reliant India.

The main objectives of formation of RDC will be to:

1. create a conducive environment for enhanced research productivity.
2. encourage collaboration with Governmental and Non-Governmental bodies with a view to enhance research.
3. facilitate greater access to research through mobilization of resources and funding.

Dean, RDC will look after the research & consultancy services in the college with the able guidance and support of the members of the cell.

Salient features of Research Policy @ DAV College, Jalandhar

1. Each faculty member must aspire to publish at least one research paper per semester.
2. Faculty members should undertake quality research leading to publications in the Research Journals of national and international repute, indexed in Scopus/WoS/UGC approved, preferably with impact factor. Faculty can explore the Scopus to find out the list of Journals for their respective subjects.
3. The appointments and promotions will be linked to the research and academic activities and strictly follow UGC/Government regulations.
4. It is mandatory to mention 'DAV College, Jalandhar' in author's affiliation in proper format.
5. A soft copy of publication must be submitted to the office of Principal (principal@davjalandhar.com), IQAC (iqac@davjalandhar.com) and Research and Development Cell (research@davjalandhar.com).
6. Quality, integrity and ethics in research must be ensured.
7. After attending the conference, a certificate of participation must also be submitted to Research and Development Cell.
8. The INFLIBNET membership is available in college library. The faculty members should avail the facility to the maximum.
9. Workshops/Interactions on Research Methodology/Research Ethics/IPR will be organised to promote research in the college.
10. Faculty must aspire for national and international collaborations and extramural funding for holding Seminars/Conferences.
11. The college maintains a Research Corpus fund to provide financial incentives to encourage the faculty to apply and complete funded major / minor research projects. Research and Development Cell will provide support to the faculty members for the well-in-time submission of major / minor research projects.
12. In addition, the college has provision for seed funding in Annual budget. Research activities of faculty and students will be supported through the grants under Seed money policy.

13. As per UGC, Guidelines the college will support research project proposals of the faculty with Seed money (upper limit Rs. 10,000/-, Max. 5 projects per year) subject to the availability of the grant.
 - i. The duration of the project will be one year.
 - ii. A half-yearly project report will be submitted to the Principal's office and Research and Development Cell.
 - iii. Research awards and appreciation certificates will be given annually to faculty and students for outstanding research work.
14. Faculty is advised to undertake socially useful research with potential for commercialisation/IPR and other similar activities.
15. Provision of Academic leave for attending conferences/delivering extension lectures (maximum three leaves per session).
16. Provision for Registration fee to attend National/International conference subject to availability of funds.
17. The faculty members will be granted **one research leave** for publishing research papers in Scopus/WoS indexed journals (without SJR/IF value)/ Hindi, Punjabi journals listed in UGC care list and **two research leaves** for publishing research papers in Scopus/WoS indexed journals (with SJR/IF value).
